Ambition

- ESPON 2020 Cooperation Programme:
 - Offer territorial monitoring systems for 4 macro-regions
 - Tailor-made systems with links to the European territorial monitoring system of ESPON
 - Maintain and update macro regional territorial monitoring systems constructed
- State of progress
 - Screening of interest
 - Alpine Space, Danube and Baltic Sea Region expressed interest so far
 - BSR the front runner – first dialogue

Approach

- Territorial monitoring of strategies for EU macro-regions
 - Capture strategic priorities
 - Measure fulfilment of targets
 - Use indicators predefined in strategy
 - Complement with further indicators
 - Include European context indicators
 - Provide evidence in support of internal action
 - Benchmark the macro-region in wider context
 - Provide basis for reporting on progress and impacts related to the evaluation and promotion of the strategy
- ESPON has successfully tested a BSR Territorial Monitoring System with VASAB (TeMo)
