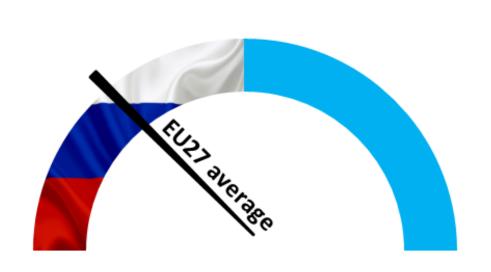
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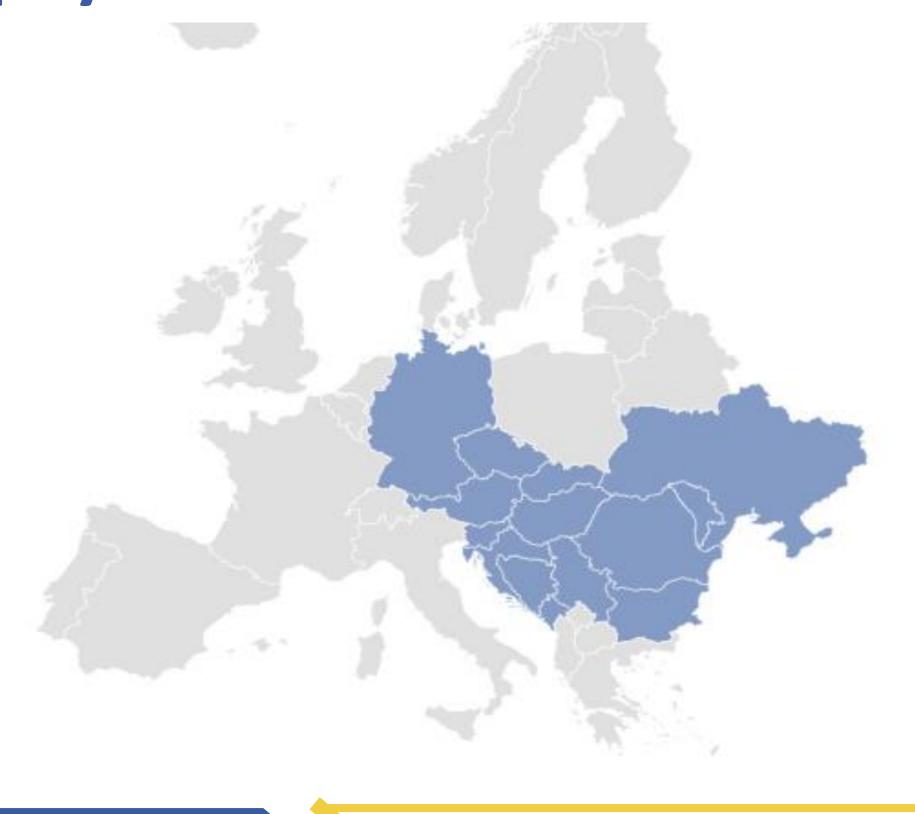




Russian gas has been dominant source of gas supply in the DR

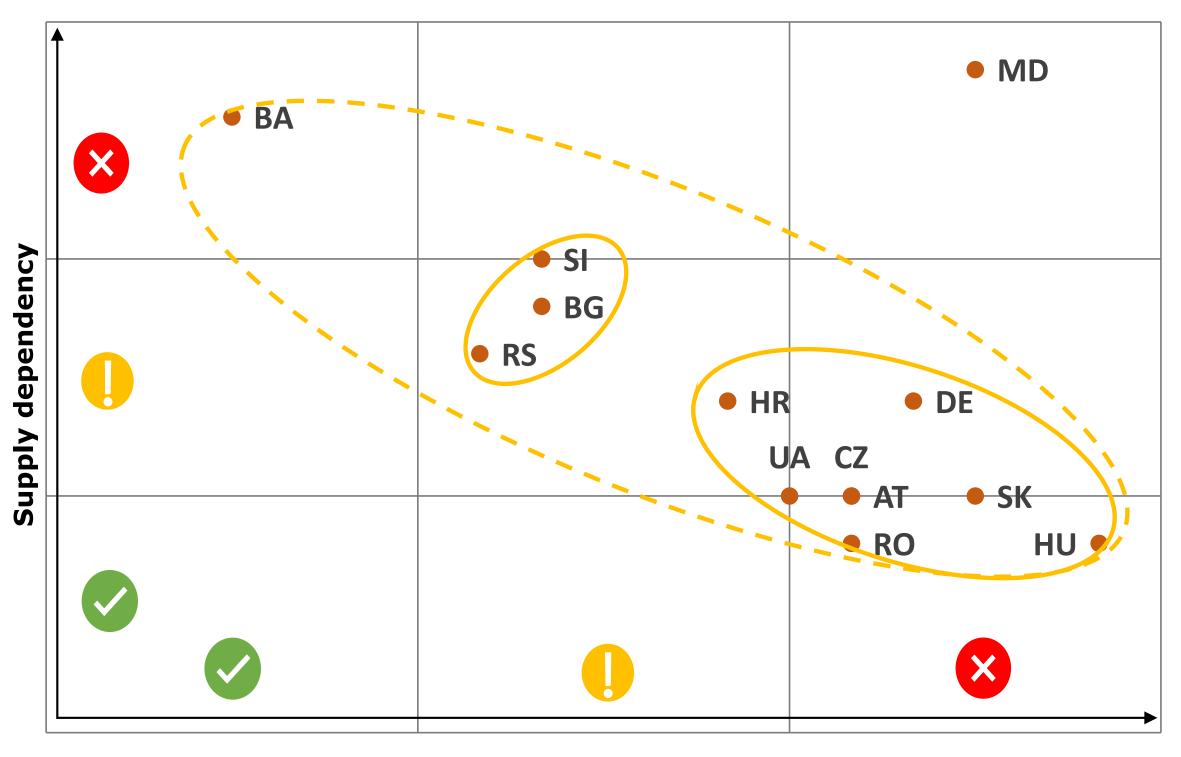

RUSSIAN GAS DEPENDENCY



Different problems required different solutions

- Countries with high share of gas in the primary energy mix sould secure source diversification
- Countries with high import dependency tend to use less gas
- Outlier: Moldova 100% RU gas, widely used in all sectors



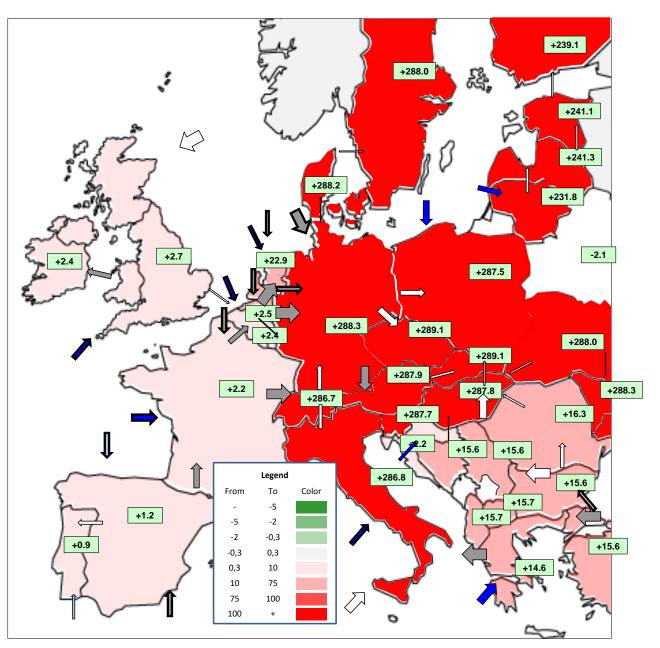
Demand dependency

WITHOUT ANY RU GAS

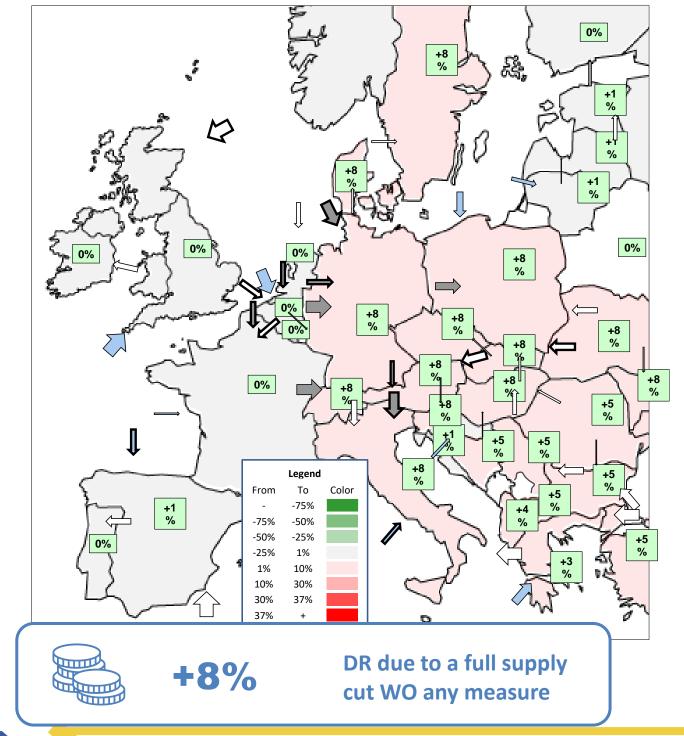
Change of wholesale yearly price in €/MWh compared to 2021 average

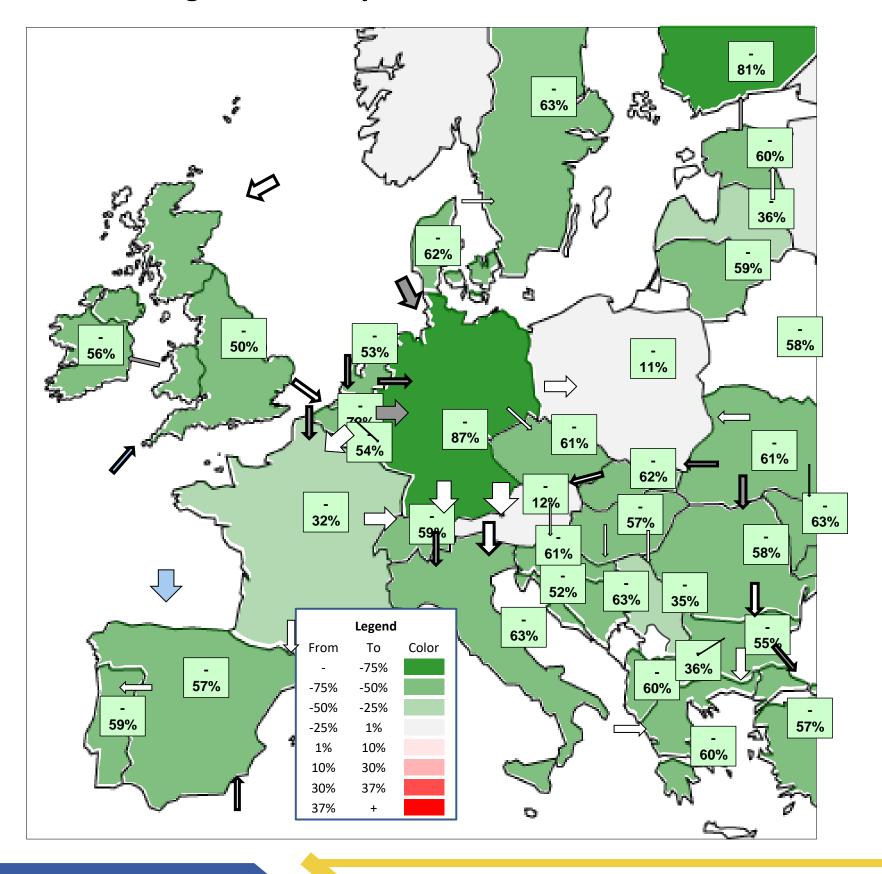

MUCH HAS BEEN DONE

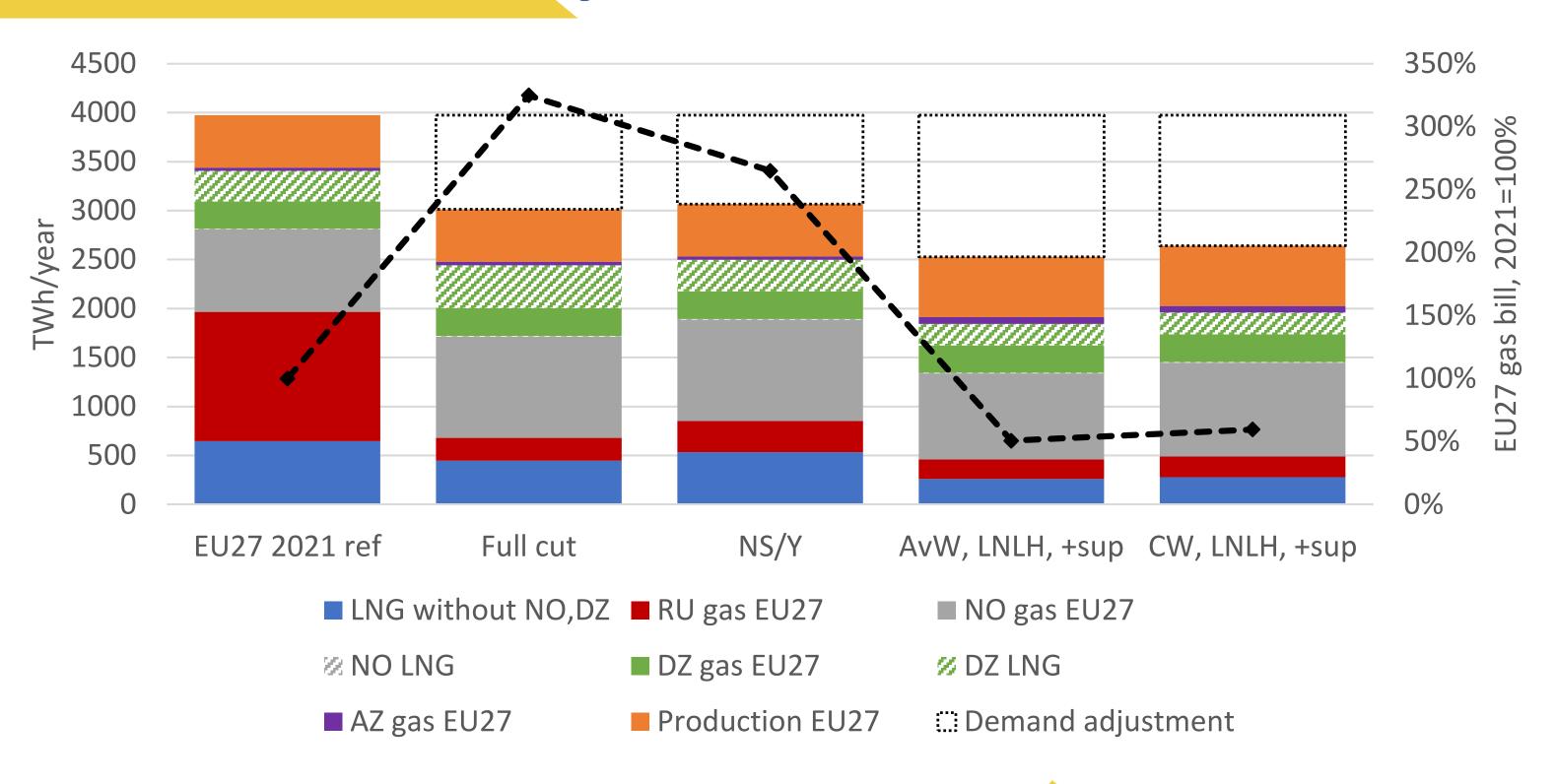
- Compared to full cut without any measures, notable (50-90%) price decrease in all countries in February
- Driven by additional LNG (DE,NL,FI)
- Demand response drives other countries

A new equilibrium without RU gas

- less consumption, lower bill



Conclusion - policy messages

Demand response

- Due to the price increase, industrial and HH sector reacted and curbed their demand
- Power sector's gas saving potential depends on French nuclear and hydro availability

Next winter will be worse

 With no RU gas filling up the storages will be a challange Solidarity and interconnected ness

Price signals are needed

Residential sector was sofar partially shielded, there is further potential in demand reduction
