## Cooperation area







## Budget framework



- ERDF = 107 Mio EUR
   (excl. national co financing and CH/LIE
   contribution)
- Co-financing rate = 75%
- Estimation to finance around 100 projects

# Small-scale projects: typology



New form of cooperation: shorter duration and less partners

- → laboratory for new ideas
- → address innovative subjects from a thematic/territorial perspective
- → deliver knowledge through analysis, experimentation or fieldwork
- → tool to react to any unexpected and/or emerging trend

### "setting-the-scene"

→ aim = opening up new perspectives for cooperation

### "roll-out"

- → bring and "roll-out" available tools and solutions into boosting their implementation and use in the territories
  - promote the up-take of project achievements for greater impact and added value both at local and regional level
  - focus on mature fields of cooperation where a body of knowledge is already available and tested by stakeholders
