- What is NOT supported
  - Pre-dominant focus on <u>infrastructure</u>
  - Pre-dominant focus on <u>research and data collection without translating into applied</u> solutions /policy strategies, plans
  - Pre-dominant focus on <u>technical solution without uptake</u> by target users

### transnational impact:

 based on the planned activities and outputs the impact of the project can be considered relevant on transnational scale and not only on local level in different parts of the region

### SO 1.1 Enhancing innovation and technology transfer in Danube region

- **Focus 1.** RDI related transnational policies and processes for closing innovation gaps and towards the uptake of innovation and advanced technologies e.g. artificial intelligence, nanotechnologies, advanced materials, advanced manufacturing and processing (production technologies) and biotechnology.
- **Focus 2.** Transnational RDI related activities for <u>capacity building along thematic value chains</u>.
- **Focus 3.** <u>Technology transfer and technology uptake</u> towards and from SMEs and improved <u>access to quadruple transnational research and innovation infrastructures</u> with macro-regional significance.

**Focus 1:** Harmonised capacities and data availability in DR scale CC forecasting and vulnerability assessment to support policy making and awareness raising

**Focus 2:** C<u>oordinated disaster prevention, preparedness and response</u> activities on environmental risks, on <u>floods, droughts, or accidental pollution of rivers on transnational river(-basin) scale</u> and CC related other disasters (wildfires, heat waves)

**Focus 3:** Strengthen preparedness and adaptive capacity of society (including also disaster management organisations, volunteer rescue teams), economy and nature to cope with impacts of CC and establish climate services to foster resilience
