

Over 200 officers from Satu Mare County Gendarmerle Inspectorate and Ivano-Frankivsk unit 1241 of National Guard of Ukraine were involved in train-Ings, study visits and experience exchange activities under the ICBS project almed at reinforcing prevention and fight against organized crime in the border regions between Romania and Ukraine. The project activities helped to Increase the trust of citizens in public order forces by 3% in Romania and by 8% in Ukraine.

Decreasing the police response time in Lviv (UA) from 15 to 5 minutes, when Informed about a crime, is the objective of the SoDR project. According to a survey conducted in Lviv, 76% of inhabitants feel safe in the city during the day and only 40% at night. The project implementation aims to increase these numbers to 85% and 60% respectively. A new administrative building equipped with a system of data collection from CCTV city cameras and an Integrated multiservice telecommunication system, six reconstructed police stations, an improved emergency communication subsystem are the key elements brought in by the project to improve the work of the emergency services and to provide security and required help to the citizens and visitors of Lviv.
