Challenge:





Enabling citizens participation in promoting the city to tourists, workers and business



Network outputs:

- Implementation of pilot digital services to visitors
- Creation of a territorial marketing strategy with relevant stakeholders of the city
- Creation of a bilateral exchange with Murcia (Spain) to get inspired on their digital co-creative process for neighbourhood regeneration
- Joint strategy between the city and the Chamber of Commerce labelled "URBACT Good Practice"




