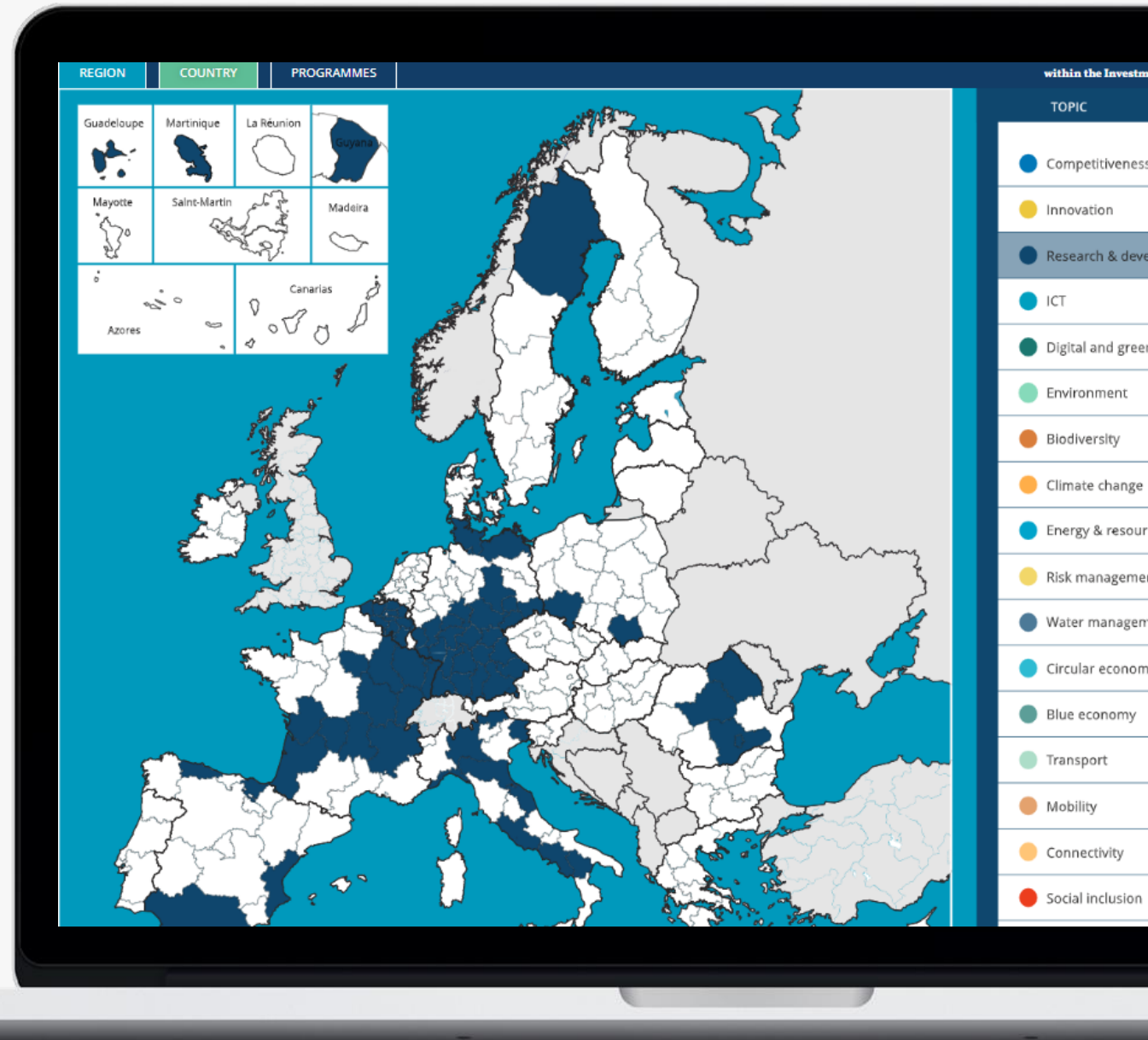

- Search option at the level of NUTS III regions and MS.



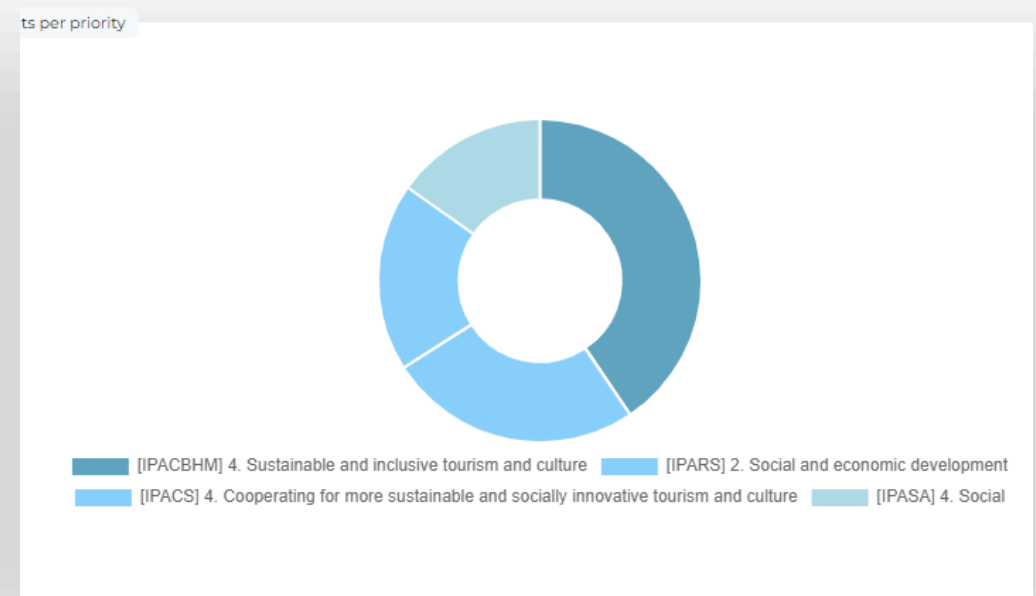
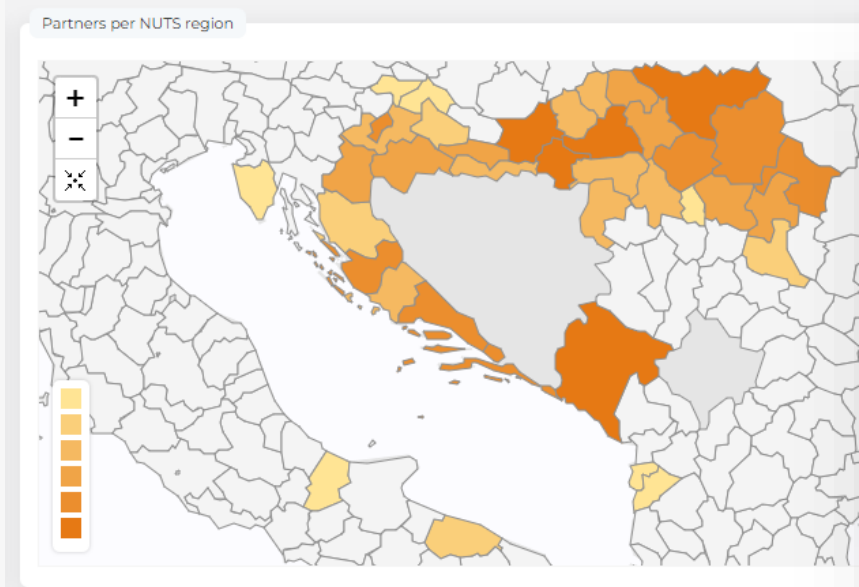

Interact developed a tool allowing automated data exchange across Interreg programmes starting from the application stage called Index. There are currently three pilots implemented, including a cluster of Interreg IPA CBC programmes and Programmes in MED area.

Stronger focus on gathering programme input regarding several programme implementation aspects: performance-based approach and future SCOs, synergies and cooperation, territorial instruments, external cooperation, flexibility and adaptability of programmes, greener Europe and Interreg specific objective on Better governance



Role of MRS - what is wished for the future

More **targeted thematic collaboration** with funding programmes in the geographical area, showing how **MRS add value** to Interreg projects

MRS could **strengthen their role in creating a joint long-term vision** for developing the geographical area and fostering measures to get stronger political ownership and support for this vision and objectives. This can serve as a valuable orientation for drafting the next Interreg programmes
